

Stop Signs

2. There are three 4-way intersections in the subdivision. Should one, two or all have 4-way stop signs added? (Note: Several of these locations are school bus stops)

- Yes- (for all 3 locations) Due to limited visibility at some of these make it a hazard for some to stop and others to not. Snow is an issue on a short term.
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) If they are bustops.
- No- (for all 3 locations) The concern is having a stop sign on a hill you are using to get out of the subdivision during ice/snow conditions. Stopping midway up on a hill during ice/snow stops your momentum making it more hazardous due to lack of traction to get out.
- No- (voted for Hermitage & Waybridge only) -The stop sign at Turnbridge and Waybridge needs to be replaced. It's incredibly dangerous. I almost get hit once a week at that spot. The stop sign was stolen years ago and never replaced.-
- No- (for all 3 locations) People don't stop anyway.
- Yes, No, No. -Hermitage needs to stay 3 way but add a "3 Way Stop" sign to the pole.
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) Too many people are driving too fast. They will roll right through the stop signs.
- No- (for all 3 locations) at least not in winter, its hard to get up the hill unless you have some momentum.
- No- (for all 3 locations) People can self police. Save the money
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) Hopefully they will stop, even though they ignore them now.
- No- (for all 3 locations) I slow down at these intersections and mostly have no issues. But understand if there are complaints of unsafe driving.
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) I wish we could stop the speeding also, people drive way too fast on these streets.
- No- (for all 3 locations) We need to keep it the same for bad weather. Snow and ice makes stopping on a hill dangerous.
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) Because people fly right through intersections way too fast. Will hopefully make it more safe for drivers and children playing.
- No- (for all 3 locations) From what I see (looked at all 3) the orig. builder left it that way due to the grade - better as they are for winter driving especially the 1st one Hermitage/Waybridge
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) I said 1000% yes but people already don't stop at the ones we do have. Speed bumps down Hermitage would be great.
- Can MoDOT help us come up with the correct (safest) answer? We could use a least a Yield sign where Turnbridge ends at Waybridge. Used to be a Stop sign there. Also the large evergreen on the southwest corner there makes it hard to see traffic coming from the west. (Yes or No not indicated)
- No- (for all 3 locations) When it is snowy it is impossible to get up the hill if you have to stop. But there should be an understanding that you have to stop[if a bus is present.
- Not familiar with it? (Yes or No not indicated)
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) Everyone should slowdown, so make them stop.
- No-Yes-Yes- keep it as is because during snows we need to make a run for the hill. Don't know much about traffic patterns there.
- No-Yes-Yes- Would be nice if under each stop sign if it said 2-way, 3-way, or 4-way, what ever the intersection is.
- No- (for all 3 locations) It would be hard on those in winter to have to stop on hills going up. Also some people don't stop anyway. Don't waste money on signs.
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) These intersections are all very dangerous, but the Waybridge and Pine Haven is awful, my husband got into an accident there because you cannot see oncoming traffic.
- No- (for all 3 locations) The money needs to be used for street repairs.
- No- (for all 3 locations) Any stop signs going up a hill are bad. Most people don't stop at them anyway.
- No- (for all 3 locations) During winter we need a run to get up hill. 3-way stop sign works better. Main streets running into Saline Rd should have right of way. Side roads connecting to main rd should have stop signs.
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) I am most familiar with Hermitage & Waybridge. The cars exiting the subdivision speed up the hill with no regard for children or other cars.
- No, No, Yes- Remain 3 way for winter (Herm & Wayb), Leave alone (Westb and Pine H), 4-way stop, hard to see in all directions (Wayb and Pine H)
- Yes- (for all 3 locations) Let's try & slow people down!
- No- (for all 3 locations) Hermitage & Waybridge is ok. The others, I don't know.
- Hard to answer this one because when it snows & it's icy no one can stop there when going up hills, otherwise yes! Maybe put yield sign going up hill, unless icy. (Yes or No not indicated)
- Yes-No-Yes- Waybridge and Pine have is a blind turn. No one can see, everyone should stop for safety.
- Yes- Currently there is only one stop sign (Westbourne and Pine Haven only response marked)
- No- (for all 3 locations) You need the momentum going up the hill on ice.
